Greetings in the name of Christ!

Alleluia! Christ is risen! It is still the season of Easter, at least for the first half of May. We still get to enjoy the Alleluias. We still get to look upon the white paraments and be reminded we are made pure by the blood of the lamb. We still get to share the Easter greeting. But then comes Pentecost.

With the changing of the colors, white to red, with the account of Pentecost itself, all coming on the heels of Ascension, we are reminded the joys of Easter are not just for us. We are a city on a hill, a light, we are salt, we are the church, we are the body of Christ, and Christ is alive and well and active. We have work to do.

The red of the day, as with every color of the year, comes with multiple meanings, but among the most important, red brings to minds the flames of Pentecost, and also passion. The disciples were not to remain sequestered behind locked doors, the church was not to bottle itself up or hide itself away, it was not to blend in and vanish, staying comfortably out of sight and out of mind. It was to burn, to be a light, and this has never changed.

We get to proclaim Christ to the nations, we get to speak in defense of the helpless and those in any need, we get to love our enemies, we get to be the body of Christ, caring for one another, and always seeking to welcome one more into God's family. We get to forgive, even as we are forgiven each day by God. We get to live out lives of God given faith, promised in our baptisms, nourished by the body and blood of Christ. We get to live lives not focused on putting ourselves first, but always seeking to love those around us, those God has placed before us.

Life, true lasting eternal life, this is what we have received and what we get to offer to the world. And thus, red gives way to green, the color of life. When Mary Magdalene mistook Jesus for the gardener, she wasn't entirely mistaken. We know Christ is the good Shepherd of course, but many times He also refers to His work in terms of gardening, pruning, harvesting and so on. In the beginning that is what creation was, a garden, a paradise, empty of weeds, full of work that was never toilsome, everything grew, everything was full of life, and it will be again. In this hope we get to live, and this hope is what we get to share.

So, although May is a busy month, full of changes, graduations, transition to summer and so forth, including in the church itself, remember in all things Christ is ever leading us closer to Him. And as we listen, as we read His word, worship together and receive His gifts, pray without ceasing, remember many do not have what we have been given. Who will tell them, "Alleluia! Christ is risen!" if not the church? It's not that we have to, but we get to, sharing the same faith, hope, and love, that will see us into eternity through our risen Savior Jesus Christ, amen.

ASCENSION DAY AT MESSIAH: On **Thursday, May 9th**, our brothers and sisters in Christ from St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Rockford will join us here at Messiah to celebrate *The Ascension of Our Lord!* A meal will be served in the fellowship hall at **6:00 pm**, followed by the service at **7:00 pm**. Pastor Eric will preside, and Pastor Jason Peterson will preach; a joint choir led by St. Peter's retiring music director Julie Busen will provide anthems and musical leadership. The service will also be livestreamed as above.

SUMMER WORSHIP UPDATE: At their April meeting, the Board of Elders set Messiah's summer worship schedule. From **Sunday, May 26th** (Memorial Day weekend) through **Sunday, September 1st** (Labor Day weekend), we'll continue with the Sunday schedule as above. Monday night services will also be held from **Monday, June 3rd through Monday, August 26th at 7:00 pm**.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION UPDATE: During the first three Sundays in May, we'll continue supplying families of Sunday School-aged children with weekly lessons from Concordia Publishing House's *Enduring Faith* curriculum. Messiah's Board of Education hopes that this helps and enables parents & grandparents to take the lead in fostering our children's spiritual growth.

WORSHIP IN MAY

On the first two Sundays in May and for the Ascension of Our Lord, we will continue to pray Divine Service, Setting Three from *Lutheran Service Book*. For **Sunday, May 19**th, the Day of Pentecost, we will pray the festive Divine Service, Setting Five, then switch to Divine Service, Setting Four for the first portion of *the Time of the Church*, the Sundays after Pentecost.

While the seasons of Advent through Easter focus on specific events in the life of Christ, the Time of the Church focuses on Jesus' ministry – His preaching and teaching, healings and miracles – as recorded for us in the Gospels of Mark and John. We'll begin the Time of the Church with **Trinity Sunday, May 26**th; this day will also feature the responsive reading of the *Athanasian Creed*, in which we speak together the profound Biblical truths of the Holy Trinity and Christ's full divinity and humanity.
